Artistic - **Meadow** Creative Line Design, using flowers and plant material gathered from your yard or the supermarket. In Creative Line Design the line is dominant, emphasized by using a limited number of components and plant material, organized in a linear direction. Line may be vertical, horizontal, diagonal, or circular. Characterized by an open silhouette; eye movement is featured line direction is emphasized.



Horticulture - Any Annual, 1 stem if large, 3 stems if small.
